About CQuIPS and MGH Partnership:

The University of Toronto Centre for Quality Improvement and Patient Safety (CQuIPS) is recruiting an Associate Director and Michael Garron Hospital (MGH) Site Lead. CQuIPS (www.cquips.ca) is an Extra-Departmental Unit-C, governed by guidelines established by the Office of the Vice-Provost, Academic Programs. CQuIPS is an international leader in quality improvement (QI) research and a world-class hub for QI teaching and learning with a deep network of over 1,500 members and alumni that work within Toronto Academic Health Sciences Network (TAHSN) institutions and beyond. Since 2020, CQuIPS researchers have received more than \$40M in peer-reviewed grants and published and published over 300 articles in high-impact journals. In 2023, CQuIPS assumed oversight of the SQUIRE international QI writing guidelines, making it the standard bearer for QI globally.

Michael Garron Hospital is a leading urban community teaching hospital serving one of Canada's most diverse populations. As the newest member of CQuIPS—and its only community hospital partner—MGH brings a vital community-based, equity-informed perspective to CQuIPS' academic mission.

The successful candidate will join the CQuIPS leadership team alongside the Director and Associate Directors from SickKids, Sunnybrook, and Women's College Hospital, contributing to core activities and strategic priorities.

- A Michael Garron Hospital staff member or credentialed clinician with demonstrated experience leading, teaching, and coaching quality improvement and/or patient safety initiatives.
- A record of meaningful impact on clinical or system performance.
- Advanced QI training (e.g., Master's degree or recognized QIPS certificate) or a clear track record demonstrating QI expertise is a strong asset.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Serve as the primary liaison between CQuIPS and Michael Garron Hospital quality improvement and patient safety programs.
- Lead or contribute to 2–3 major CQuIPS activities (e.g., education programs, TAHSN QIPS Community of Practice initiatives, strategic priorities, or research studies, co-lead the CQuIPS Patient Advisory Committee).
- Participate in weekly 30–60 minute CQuIPS leadership or working meetings.
- Teach 4–5 half-day sessions within CQuIPS education programs and contribute to CQuIPS-led research.
- Provide mentorship to MGH faculty, staff, and learners engaged in QI through CQuIPS programs.
