Colon Cancer Screening Diagnostic Assessment Unit

Dear Colleagues,

Michael Garron Hospital | Toronto East Health Network offers Fast Track Colonoscopy Screening to all patients referred to our unit with:

- 1. a positive Fecal Occult Blood Test (FOBT) between the ages of 50 and 75
- 2. a Family History of colon cancer in a first degree relative (age 40 or 10 years younger than the relative)
- 3. concerning symptoms or findings (i.e. rectal bleeding, change in bowel habits, abnormal imaging findings)

We will make all further arrangements with the patient including any colorectal surgical or GI medical follow-up.

Cancer Care Ontario (CCO) wants patients to get colonoscoped within 8 weeks of the positive FOBT date and within 6 months for Family History.
